Colombia's dirty war, responsible for massacres, forced population displacements, assassinations and the imprisonment of dissidents, is not a local conflict unfamiliar to Canada. You run **Pacific Rubiales**, a Canadian oil company operating on Colombia's territory.

You are war profiteers because:

- Your employees work up to 18 hours per day and up to 40 days in a row without any days off, and for starvation wages;
- Demonstrations held by workers and local residents were quelled by the Colombian army, leaving 50 wounded;
- As punishment for these demonstrations, oil companies in the area, including yours, fired more than 500 employees suspected of union activities, and union leaders received death threats from paramilitary units.
